UTM Women and Gender Equity Centre strives to make our campus safer and more accessible for women, Indigenous folks, trans folks, and nonbinary folks.

As an Events Volunteer, you will be expected to:

- Attend training that outlines gender & sexuality, and allyship and advocacy
- Run a minimum of one event that advocates women & gender equity and promotes the WGEC. The type of event (workshop, guest speaker, photo contest, etc), and what the event will concern is up to the volunteers. We encourage virtual events to accommodate for all students on and off-campus this semester. If an in-person event is collectively proposed by the volunteer team, it will need to be accompanied by a virtual event, and necessary COVID procedure & protocol will need to be followed and enforced.
- Meet with fellow volunteers, at an agreed upon time and frequency, to plan and run the event
- Meet with WGEC executives to pitch the event and discuss changes

Qualifications:

- You must be a registered full-time/part-time UTM student

Duration & Location

- Training and event planning will begin at the end of February and extend to the end of March or the start of April (depending on when the event is decided to take place).
- The volunteer position will be virtual.

Compensation:

- A reference letter and \$50 gift card to a place of your choice will be provided to you after the event has taken place.
